Windows 7 Broadband (Wireless) Connection Settings:

Click Start > Control Panel and then in the upper right corner of control panel you'll see View By: and you can choose either large or small icons.

Then click on Network and Sharing Center

Under "Change your networking settings" click on "Set up new connection or network."

Choose a connection option: Connect to the Internet (highlighted blue) then click Next

How do you want to Connect? Click and highlight "Broadband (PPPoE)", then click Next

Type in the username for your account (do not include the @mtida.net here).

Type in your password and then put a check in front of remember password.

The connection name is Mtida WiFi.

Place a check in front of "Allow other people to use this connection."

Click on Connect button. (You may only have an option to "Create" or "Cancel". If so, Click on connect. This action will save your settings).

Go back to Control Panel and Network and Sharing Center again, and look at left hand side. Click "Change Adapter Settings"

Locate Mtida icon, left mouse click the Mtida icon, select "Create Shortcut". A message will appear: Windows cannot create a shortcut here. Do you want the shortcut to be placed on the desktop instead?" Click Yes.

Close control panel and you will see a Mtida shortcut on your desktop. To connect to the Internet, click this icon and connect manually from the desktop when you do not have a router. This is the most secure way to connect to the internet.
